RESOLVE, in Favor of Clarence Ricker of Clinton.

Clarence Ricker; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,500 from the funds of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, to be paid to Clarence Ricker, of Clinton, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for damage to his crops by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Clarence Ricker claims damage to his crops by deer in 1949. Planted 8 acres of beans. Feels he should be compensated for damage done by deer.
