RESOLVE, Reappropriating Road Resolve Funds in Town of Penobscot.

Town of Penobscot; money reappropriated. Resolved: That the special resolve apportionment of \$1,500 allocated by the Ninety-third Legislature, to aid in repairing route No. 175 starting at the Orland-Penobscot line to the Penobscot-Castine town line, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended to aid in repairing the road designated on State Highway Commission records as a part of state aid No. 1, extending from the junction of state aid No. 2 (state route No. 175) southerly and westerly to the Penobscot-Castine town line, said road also being a part of state route No. 199.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The apportionment of \$1,500 to repair route No. 175 has not been expended and since this route is now badly in need of repair this money should be reappropriated for that purpose.
