RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Crosby Pond in Coburn Gore, Franklin County.

Fishing in Crosby Pond in Coburn Gore, Franklin County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Crosby Pond in Coburn Gore in Franklin county to fishing under the general law for Franklin county except that it shall be unlawful to use fish of any kind as bait; and be it further

Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit and possession limit of 5 fish per person per day from Crosby Pond in Coburn Gore, Franklin county.
