RESOLVE, Relating to Night Fishing for Smelts in Long Lake, Aroostook County.

Fishing for smelts in Long Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting night fishing for smelts in Long Lake in St. Agatha, Frenchville, Madawaska, Township 17 Range 3 and Township 17 Range 4 in Aroostook County with not more than 3 hooks per line not larger than No. 6 and not less than 3 nor more than 5 inches apart.
