STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Bail Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 126, § 35, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 35 of chapter 126 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Such bail commissioner shall receive not exceeding the sum of \$5 \$10 in each case in which bail is so taken, the same to be paid by the person so admitted to bail; but the person admitted to bail shall not be required to pay any other fees or charges to any officer for services connected with the giving of such bail.'

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
