STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Delivery of Motor Vehicles Sold by State on Bids.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 38-A, additional. Chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 38-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 38-A. Motor vehicles sold by State. All motor vehicles sold by the State to private individuals on bid shall be delivered to such purchasers within 14 days after such bid has been accepted by the State. This section shall not apply to exchange of motor vehicles for new models between the State and authorized dealers.'
