AN ACT Relating to Retail Licenses for Sale of Malt Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, § 32, amended. The 1st sentence of section 32 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'No license for sale and distribution of malt liquor in retail stores shall be issued unless the application therefor be approved by the municipal officers of the municipality where such retail store is located, and if such retail store is located in an unorganized place, the application shall be approved by the county commissioners of the county within which such unorganized place is located.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 61, § 32, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 32 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed as follows:

'Provided, however, that licenses in an unincorporated place, where no local option vote is taken under the provisions of section 23, shall require the approval of the county commissioners of the county.'
