Amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined word "cul-  
ture" at the end of the 4th line the following underlined words:

'who has been a resident of the State of Maine for a period  
of at least 6 months,'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, before the single quotation mark, the following underlined sentence:

'The applicant shall pay to the Board a fee of \$3.'
