STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Permit Before Examination for Applicant to Practice Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 224, amended. Section 224 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'If any applicant to practice hairdressing and beauty culture qualifies for examination, the Board may issue to such applicant until the time for holding an examination a permit to practice hairdressing and beauty culture under the supervision of a person registered to practice hairdressing and beauty culture. Such applicant shall not be considered an apprentice.'
