RESOLVE, to Reimburse the City of South Portland for Support of Margaret Dawson.

City of South Portland; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,027.16 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the city of South Portland to reimburse said city for support of Margaret Dawson; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Margaret Dawson cannot get old age assistance even though she is 84 years old. She needed help and the city of South Portland seeks to be reimbursed.
