COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 220, L. D. 561, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Jurisdiction of Cases of Forcible Entry
and Detainer of Recorders of Municipal Courts."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the word "interested" in
the 8th line the underlined words 'and except in such cases in
which such justices, judges or recorders are the plaintiffs'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following underlined sentence 'Such cases in which such justices,
judges or recorders are the plaintiffs may be made returnable
before any other municipal court within their county.'
