## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation under The Workmen's Compensation Act for Death of Employee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 15, amended. The 1st sentence of section 15 of chapter 31 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'If death results from the injury, the employer shall pay the dependents of the employee, wholly dependent upon his earnings for support at the time of his accident, a weekly payment equal to 2/3 his average weekly wages, earnings or salary, but not more than \$27 \$36 nor less than \$15 a week, from the date of death for a period ending 300 weeks from the date of the accident, and in no case to exceed \$8,000 \$10,500.'
