COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 224, L. D. 565, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Registration of Architects."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of Section 1 thereof and
inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., c. 81, Sec. 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of
section 1 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes is hereby amended
to read as follows:

'The Board shall be composed of 3 5 practicing architects,
or 2 4 practicing architects and 1 professor of architecture, who
shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of
the Council, to serve for 3 years and until their successors are
duly appointed and qualified. Each member of the Board shall
receive a certificate of his appointment from the Governor and
~~shall-serve-without-pay.~~'"
