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**AN ACT Relating to Hours of Opening and Closing Barber Shops.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 25, § 215, amended.** Section 215 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

‘The State Board of Barbers and Hairdressers shall have the power after investigations and hearing to make rules, regulations and orders prescribing the hours for opening and closing of barbershops in each municipality, when and if petitioned by 70% of the barbers in that particular municipality.’
