HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 235, L.D. 571, Bill, "An Act Relating to Fees for Motor Vehicle Inspections."

Amend said Bill by striking out, in the 4th line of the 4th paragraph, the underlined amount "10d" and inserting in place thereof the underlined amount '15d'

Further amend said Bill, in said 4th paragraph, by adding after the 2nd sentence, the following underlined sentence: 'One-third of all moneys derived from the sale of stickers shall be appropriated for the use of the state police for the purpose of enforcing the law and rules and regulations relating to inspection stations as provided in section 46.

Further amend said Bill by adding after Section 1 thereof, the following section:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, Sec. 46, amended. Section 46 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

'The state police shall periodically inspect all such stations licensed under this section for the purpose of determining if the statutes and rules and regulations promutgated by the Secretary of State with reference to inspection of motor vehicles are being complied with.'"

Further amend said Bill by renumbering Section 2 to be Section 3.
