STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse George H. Morong, of Portland.

George H. Morong; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$1,200 to be paid to George H. Morong, of Portland, to reimburse him for expenses incurred in an investigation for the determination of work projects and soliciting markets for hand-manufactured articles for the rehabilitation of the Passamaquoddy and the Penobscot Indians.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Pursuant to suggestion of the Governor and Council, this work was undertaken and was carried on for a period of approximately 6 months.
