**AN ACT Relating to Tuition of Students Living on Chebeague Island,
Cumberland County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 41, § 107, amended. Section 107 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :

'Notwithstanding the foregoing, the town of Cumberland may pay the tuition, and in addition, conveyance of board subject to the regulations of the superintending school committee, of any student whose parent or guardian resides on Chebeague Island, for attendance at any approved secondary school. These expenditures shall be subject to state subsidy under section 237.'
