RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Little Jim Pond, Franklin and Somerset Counties.

Little Jim Pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Little Jim Pond, situated in Jim Pond township, counties of Franklin and Somerset, for fishing under the general law, with anything for bait except fish, with a daily bag limit of 5 trout or togue per person.
