AN ACT Relating to Actions Against Towns for Slippery Sidewalks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 96, § 92, repealed and replaced. Section 92 of chapter 96 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 92. Slippery sidewalk no cause of action. No town is liable for damages to any person on foot on account of the slippery condition of any sidewalk, crosswalk or way, due to ice or snow.'
