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**AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Liquor Inspectors.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 61, § 8, sub-§ XVII, amended.** The 1st sentence of subsection XVII of section 8 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'To appoint, subject to the ~~provisions of the personnel law~~ **approval of the Governor and Council**, a chief inspector and as many inspectors as may from time to time be found necessary **to serve during the pleasure of the Commission, whose compensation shall be fixed by the Commission, subject to the approval of the Governor and Council.**'
