IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Providing for Tax on Non-returnable Malt Liquor Bottles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 61**, § 22, amended. Section 22 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting before the last paragraph thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'There shall be levied and imposed a tax of 2c upon each individual nonreturnable bottle or can of malt liquor imported or manufactured in this State. All moneys so received by the Commission shall be forthwith turned over to the Treasurer of State and shall accrue to the general highway fund.'
