HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 549, L.D. 606, Bill, "An Act Relating to Instruction in Schools of Barbering."

Amend said Bill by striking out, in the 10th line, the stricken out figure "1,000" and the underlined figure "1,500" and inserting in place thereof the figure '1,000'

Further amend said Bill, in the 11th line, by striking out the stricken out figure "6" and the underlined figure: "9" and inserting in place thereof the figure '6'

Further amend said Bill by adding after the word and punctuation "months," in the 11th line thereof, the following underlined
words and punctuation: 'or in lieu thereof has satisfactorily
completed a course of instruction of 1,500 hours in not less than 9
months in a school of barbering approved by said Board,'
