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**AN ACT Relating to Failure of Towns to Remit Dog License Fees.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 100, § 9, amended.** The last paragraph of section 9 of chapter 100 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'If any city or town fails to remit to the Treasurer of State on or before October 15 of each year a sum of money equal to the licenses required by sections 9 to 28, inclusive, on all dogs living on the 15th day of June preceding, such deficiency shall be added to the state tax of such delinquent city or town for the following year collected in the manner provided by section 13 of chapter 18.'
