COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 622, L. D. 628, Bill, "An Act to Create the Brunswick Parking Authority."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 4 (a), (8), the following:

'except, however, that no products used in or for the servicing of motor vehicles, other than municipally owned or operated motor vehicles, shall be sold or dispensed at or in connection with public off-street parking facilities by the District or any lessee thereof,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the period following the word "meeting" at the end of the last line of the 1st paragraph of the Referendum clause and insert in place thereof the following:

'; provided that the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this act at said meeting equals or exceeds 20% of the total vote for all candidates for Governor in said town at the next previous gubernatorial election.'
