RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of New Gloucester.

Town of New Gloucester; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of New Gloucester, the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956, and the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957, for tuition for children of Opportunity Farm who are being educated in the public schools of New Gloucester; such amount to be paid from the general fund of the state on requisition of the Commissioner of Education.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are about 30 children of Opportunity Farm who are being taught in the public schools of New Gloucester which creates a heavy financial burden on the town.
