STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Leonard and Alta M. Mitchell, Owners, of Palmyra, and the Merchant's National Bank, Mortgagee, of Bangor for Damages to Real Estate.

Leonard and Alta Mitchell reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Leonard and Alta M. Mitchell of Palmyra, with the endorsement of their mortgagee, the Merchants National Bank of Bangor, the sum of \$4,000 from the general highway fund, as a full and final settlement of their claim against the State for damages to their real estate and business in Palmyra, caused by the Maine State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the process of new road construction adjoining the property a rock drain was disturbed and replaced by a dry-well under State supervision. The new dry-well did not operate as planned, resulting in damage to the house by virtue of 2 to 3 feet of water standing in the cellar and destroying a well that had been used for many years for water supply.
