IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Floral Grange in Bucksport.

Floral Grange compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Floral Grange, of Bucksport, the sum of \$500 from the general highway fund as a full and final settlement of their claim against the State for damages incurred in relocating State Highway #15.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Highway #15 in Bucksport was relocated so that it now leaves only about 12 feet in front of Floral Grange Hall. It is now necessary to move the Hall back from the road.
