RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Swan's Island.

Town of Swan's Island; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$1,594.88 to be paid to the town of Swan's Island to reimburse them for aid and supplies furnished Everett Carter and family.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Everett Carter, his wife and family moved to Swans Island about 1921. Stayed until 1936. During that time they were resident paupers of the town of Brooklin and Brooklin paid their pauper bill. In 1936 the Carters left Swans Island and went to Vinalhaven. In 1944 they moved back to the Town of Swans Island. During the time from 1944 to 1950 they were furnished pauper supplies by the Town of Swans Island to the extent of \$1,594.88. Due to the inadvertence or knowledge of the Overseer of Poor of Swans Island they became settled with the expense of this family. There are three of the family who are now paupers or may be paupers, that is, Mrs. Carter, Leverett Carter, who is non compos mentis, and the father, Everett Carter, although Everett Carter is not living with his wife.
