**RESOLVE, Designating Part of Green Lake Road as State Aid Highway.**

---

**Green Lake Road designated as State Aid Highway. Resolved:** That the State Highway Commission be and hereby is directed and authorized to designate the Green Lake Road in the town of Dedham, Hancock county, as a State Aid Highway from the easterly end of designated State Aid #5 at Jellison brook then easterly and southeasterly along the northerly shore of Green lake 1½ miles to the westerly boundary of Acadia National Park.
