**AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Hunting with Bow and Arrow in
York County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 37, § 108, amended. Section 108 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 108. Open season. There shall be an annual open season on deer in all counties of the State, except that portion of Piscataquis county south of the main line of the Canadian Pacific railway and all of Waldo county, beginning on the 1st Monday of October for a period of 15 days including such 1st Monday, for the purpose of hunting deer with bow and arrow only, **except in York county where the season will commence on the 1st day of October and continue up to the 1st day of the regular open season for deer.**'
