AN ACT Increasing Bounty on Bobcats in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 121, amended. The 1st sentence of section 121 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a bounty of \$15, **except in Washington county where the bounty shall be \$20**, for every bobcat, loup cervier and Canada lynx which is killed within the State, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
