STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Power to Hold Property by Corporations Without Capital Stock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 54, § 5, amended. The 1st sentence of section 5 of chapter 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

Every corporation organized under the provisions of the preceding sections may take and hold by purchase, gift, devise of bequest, personal or real estate, in all not exceeding in value \$500,000 or in any one town 10% of that town's state valuation, owned at any one time, and may use and dispose thereof only for the purposes for which the corporation was organized.'
