AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Operating After Suspension of License to Operate Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 161, amended. Section 161 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘The Secretary of State, upon receipt of a duly attested copy of the court record of the conviction of any person charged with driving a motor vehicle while such person’s license or right to operate was under suspension in this State, shall extend the period of such suspension for a like period when the license or right to operate is under suspension for a definite period. If the conviction was upon a charge of driving while a license or right to operate was revoked as a result of a conviction for driving under the influence of intoxicating liquor or manslaughter arising out of the operation of a motor vehicle, the Secretary of State shall not issue a new license for an additional period of one year from and after the date such person would otherwise have been entitled to apply for a new license.’
