STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Trespass on Certain Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 131, § 39-A, additional. Chapter 131 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 39-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 39-A. Trespass on certain buildings. Whoever willfully enters any dwelling house, camp, cottage or other building in which valuable things are then and there kept, without the permission of the owner or occupant thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
