HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 600, L.D. 656, Resolve,
Authorizing Alfred Howard, Sr., and
Ethel M. Howard of Moscow to Sue the
State of Maine.

Amend said resolve by adding before the last sen-
tence therein the following sentence:

'In no case shall damages be assessed for more than the
sum of \$4,000'

Further, amend said resolve by adding thereto the fol-
lowing:

'; and be it further

Resolved: that it is the sole intent of the Legislature to
authorize the bringing of a suit and that the passage of
this resolve shall not in any way be construed as a finding
in respect to facts or liability, and such matters as well
as the matters of damages, if any, shall be determined by
the tribunal above described.'
