STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Creditable Service Under Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 64, § 3, sub-§ IX, additional. Section 3 of chapter 64 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection IX, to read as follows:

'IX. Benefits provided by this section shall be available to any teacher or State employee who ever did complete at least 15 years of creditable service, regardless of when such service was rendered or whether or not any contributions to any system were ever made, providing such an individual has attained age 60 or more and can validate such service in a manner acceptable to the Board of Trustees.'
