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## STATE OF MAINE

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### AN ACT Relating to Salary of the Recorder and to Clerk Hire in Waldo County Municipal Court.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1941, c. 12, § 2, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 2 of chapter 12 of the private and special laws of 1941, as last amended by chapter 150 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘Said judge shall receive a salary of \$2,250 per year and said recorder shall receive a salary of ~~\$800~~ **\$2,000** per year for all services in criminal and civil cases, **with \$1,000 additional for clerk hire**, to be paid from the treasury of the county of Waldo in monthly payments on the last day of each month.’
