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### **RESOLVE, Reappropriating Road Resolve Funds in Chesuncook Township.**

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**Chesuncook Township; money reallocated. Resolved:** That the balance of \$747.33 accumulated from special road resolves allocated by previous legislatures to aid in repairing the Chesuncook-Grant Farm road, so called, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended in Lily Bay township, to aid in construction of road designated as State Aid No. 1, between the northern and southern ends of said designation.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The County Commissioners of Piscataquis County, in which both Chesuncook and Lily Bay townships are located, report the balance is practically unexpended on the described location in Chesuncook, said road having fallen into disuse. They further state that there is no other road in Chesuncook that requires use of the resolve, therefor reallocation to Lily Bay township will better serve the county and general travelling public.
