**AN ACT Relating to Itemized Statements Filed by Legislative Counsel
and Agents.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 10, § 37-A, additional. Chapter 10 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 37-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 37-A. Statements. Within 30 days after Final Adjournment of the Legislature, every legislative counsel or agent shall file with the Secretary of State an itemized statement under oath of his fees and expenditures in connection with such legislative employment and by whom paid or to whom charged. Such statement shall be in such form as the Secretary of State may prescribe and shall be open to public inspection.'
