COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 250, L. D. 682, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Appointment of Special Deputy Sheriffs."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 152. Special Deputies. Sheriffs may appoint male citizens more than 18 years of age not eligible for military service as special deputies, who shall have and exercise all the powers of deputy sheriffs appointed under the general law, except the service of civil process. Such special deputies shall be personally responsible for any unreasonable, improper or illegal acts committed by them in the performance of their duties, but the sheriffs shall not be liable upon their bonds or otherwise for any neglect or misdoings of such deputies.
