COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 254, L. D. 685, Bill, "An Act to
Clarify the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after Section 4 thereof a new section
to read as follows:

"Sec. 4-A. R. S., c. 61, Sec. 27, amended. Section 27 of
chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at
the end of the 1st paragraph a new sentence to read as follows:
'Any person, except an officer in performance of his duties, who
purchases liquor on Sunday, in any retail store, shall be guilty
of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to the same penalty provided
in this section for Sunday sale of liquor.' "

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined
word "keep" in the 4th line of "Sec. 12" the underlined words
'for 2 years'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined
word "kept" in the 11th line of "Sec. 12" the underlined words
'for 2 years'

Reported by the Committee on Liquor Control.

Read and adopted in the Senate March 29, 1955.
