AN ACT Providing for Rental of Caribou Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1905, c. 352, amended. That part designated "Sec. 5." of chapter 57 of the private and special laws of 1945, which amended chapter 352 of the private and special laws of 1905, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. The county commissioners shall provide a suitable place in Caribou for the holding of the court, and all expenses thereof shall be paid from the treasury of the county of Aroostook. **There shall be paid from the county of Aroostook, as rental, in quarterly payments, the sum of \$600 annually.'**
