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**AN ACT Relating to Killing Dogs Attacking Domestic Animals.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 100, § 24, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 24 of chapter 100 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any owner of ~~sheep~~ **domestic animals** or fowl or any member of his family or any person to whom is entrusted the custody of any ~~sheep~~ **domestic animal** or fowl shall have a right to kill any dog attacking any of said ~~sheep~~ **domestic animals** or fowl.'
