STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Killing Dogs Attacking Domestic Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 100, § 24, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 24 of chapter 100 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any owner of sheep **domestic animals** or fowl or any member of his family or any person to whom is entrusted the custody of any sheep **domestic animal** or fowl shall have a right to kill any dog attacking any of said sheep **domestic animals** or fowl.'
