AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Poultry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 92, § 6, sub-§ VI, amended. Subsection VI of section 6 of chapter 92 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘VI. All mules and horses less than 6 months old, and all colts of draught type under 3 years old, and neat cattle 18 months old and under, and all sheep to the number of 35, and swine to the number of 10, and domestic fowl to the number of 50 and **all poultry less than 4 months old** and all goats to the number of 35 and all kids less than 1 year old.’
