AN ACT Relating to Membership on State Soil Conservation Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 34, § 3, sub-§ I, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection I of section 3 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘It shall consist of the following 5 members: the Director of the State Agricultural Extension Service and the Director of the State Agricultural Experiment Station, who shall serve ex officio; and 3 farmers who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council in the following manner: + from a list of 3 names submitted by the executive committee of the state grange, + from a list of 3 names submitted by the executive committee of the state farm bureau federation and + from a list of 3 names submitted by the commissioner of agriculture from a list of 3 names for each appointment submitted by the Maine State Association of Soil Conservation District Supervisors.’
