RESOLVE, in Favor of New Canada Plantation to Repair Daigle School.

New Canada Plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 and \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957 to be expended for the following repairs at the Daigle School; these funds to be expended by the superintending school committee of New Canada Plantation:
