RESOLVE, Authorizing the Construction of an Airport at Fryeburg, Oxford County.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment ; and

Whereas, there are no airports within a radius of 50 miles of Fryeburg ; and

Whereas, air transportation facilities are vitally needed and are essential to the well-being of the people of Maine ; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary to begin construction of an airport at Fryeburg in early 1955 ; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts creates an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety ; now, therefore, be it

Construction of Airport at Fryeburg ; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$37,500 be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to the town of Fryeburg to aid in constructing an airport in such town in accordance with the specifications of the Aeronautics Commission provided that a like amount be made available by the town for such construction ; and be it further

Resolved: That such appropriation be available until June 30, 1957.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are no available airport facilities within 50 miles of Fryeburg. An airport is essential to take care of the needs of the people who live in the vicinity of Fryeburg and those who spend their vacations in the vicinity.
