AN ACT Relating to Qualifications for Real Estate Brokers' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, § 4, amended. The 1st sentence of section 4 of chapter 84 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Brokers' licenses shall be granted only to persons who are 21 years of age or over and a citizen of the United States and has served 1 year as a licensed real estate salesman, or produce evidence of satisfactory real estate experience or education equivalent thereto.'
