RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Dyer Brook.

Town of Dyer Brook; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$525 to be paid to the town of Dyer Brook to reimburse them for aid given to the Frank Knockwood family.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Knockwoods are Indians and Dyer Brook never got reimbursed from the State. At the time these bills should have been presented for payment the Town Manager was sick and nobody knew about them until the time of payment had expired. The reason for the bills on the babies being so large is that they were physically unfit to be released from the hospital sooner.
